Explanation:

a. David left after Eileen. If the first two statements are true, then the third is

Explanation:

We can diagram this as sequence follows: $D > S > E$. If it is true that David left for the airport before Sara, then he was the first of the three to leave. The third statement cannot be true.

Answer: B

Explanation:

A sniper must have good aim; a tightrope walker must have good balance.

Endearment most nearly means

Explanation:

Endearment most nearly means affection.

Explanation:

We can diagram this account as follows: $D < E < J$. If June has more than Earl, and Earl has more than Dean, then June must have more than Dean.

Answer: C

Explanation:

Football is the only item in the list that a football player cannot wear.
